YOUR FEET WILL NEVER TAKE YOU, WHERE YOUR MIND HAS NEVER BEEN

“And the Lord said to Abram, after Lot had separated from him: Lift your eyes now and look from the place where you are – northward, southward, eastward and westward; for all the land which you see I give to you and your descendants forever” (Genesis 13:14-15).

Have you ever wondered why it takes so long for you to receive an answer to your prayers? I mean, if God can really hear you when you pray; why are you still praying for the same things 2 or 3 years later? Why does it feel like your prayers can't go beyond the roof?
