## IT'S COMING TO PASS!

***"...no Word from God shall be without power or impossible of fulfillment."***

**Luke 1:37**

You may be waiting for a specific fulfillment of God's plan in your life which God promised to you some time ago. It might be your promotion at work; salary increase; a dream house; a spouse (*for singles*); healing, etc. While waiting, there might be some questions ringing in your mind, like: *When? Where? How? or Who?* I want you to know that it's normal to ask such questions. Certainly, God is an organized God and He has a plan for your future. He is still firm in His promise for you mentioned in **Jeremiah 29:11** ***"For I know the plans I have for you, declares the LORD, plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."***

God has a vision for you. And He is willing to share the vision, a glimpse of the future with you. Vision allows you to see the broader picture; the larger scope of life, the ability to see God at work and how you fit in. Vision is being able to take a step back from the situation to gain a larger perspective. Vision is being able to see the sunshine in the midst of the rain. Vision is being able to see the morning coming while you are weeping during the night. **Proverbs 29:18** says, ***"Where there is no vision, the people perish"***. There is a need to have God-given vision. God gives the vision to one to share with all, and it's up to you to catch the vision.

To catch the vision you need to keep your focus on what God says about you in His word. Don't let distractions get in your way. Don't let diversions blind you to the vision. Often people lose sight of the vision when they get caught up in the minor things. Don't let negative people distract you. People who say, *'what if it doesn't work, how long, when, etc.'* Pessimist people will hinder you from doing what God has called you to do.

The assurance from God is that ***"...no Word from God shall be without power or impossible of fulfillment"*** (**Luke 1:37**). God gives you a word of assurance, ***it will be fulfilled***. He is able to keep all His promises, no matter how unlikely their fulfillment may seem. Take the case of Abraham in the book of Genesis. He was nearly 100 years old when the Lord renewed His pledge to give him a son. And by the way, his wife Sarah was 90 years old at that time. **Romans 4: 21** give us Abraham's response to this seemingly impossible promise ***"He was fully convinced that God is able to do whatever He promises."***

There is a difference between being able and willing. If I need to buy a car, I can go to the bank to request a loan. The bank has the money and the power to give me the loan. However, just because they are able to do so, they may not be willing to do so. But God is not only ABLE to keep His promises; He is also WILLING to bring it to pass. All God's promises are guaranteed and certain. All you have to do is catch the promise from His word, meditate upon it, wait for it, for it will surely come to pass.
